BURY EAST MAKES PROGRESS

Pigeon has secured interests in over 70 acres of land within the Bury East Development, where there is an allocation for 1,250 dwellings in the St Edmundsbury Core Strategy. Together with its partner Hopkins Homes, Pigeon intends to submit a planning application during 2012.

The developers organised and paid for an Enquiry by Design, which was conducted by The Prince's Foundation for the built environment in Bury during February. The Enquiry by Design identified a number of development opportunities and constraints, and suggested a variety of development layouts in response to these.

Hopkins Homes and Pigeon are now working on the surveys and reports, which will accompany the planning application. It is hoped that planning permission will be granted within the next two years, and that development will commence soon thereafter.
